## CHAPTER IV

## RESULT OF THE STUDY

This chapter presents the description of the data and the result of the data analysis.

## A. Result of the Data

In this part, the result of the data of developing noun phrase worksheet for the second semester students at State Islamic Institute of Palangka Raya were presented by using the questionnaires.

The questionnaires included 30 items aimed for the students and 33 items for the lecturers to know the responses and needs to the noun phrase worksheet. The respondents of this research were 65 students and 2 lecturersof the State Islamic Institute of Palangka Raya.

1. Students' response related to th worksheet

2. Students' response related to the use of worksheet

In responding their answer, two students said that because the material in of the worksheet was difficult, other students said thatthe material was also less detail in explanation,the material was too complicated, and the material was too general.
3. Students' opinion related to their interest to the worksheet used in campus In responding their answers, they said that because the questions were suitable with the explanation of the examples, the questions were little bit easy and simple, the questions were difficult and complicated, the colors were only black and white, then it was not too interesting to learn, and the questions were not complicated and rather easy.
4. Students' opinion related to their interest in learning noun phrase using the worksheet
