And item number 2 the answer was it was near the writers friends house there were 3 students have correct answer. And 2 student have incorrect answer.

Code' question 2.2 B item number 1 and 2 the answer was peter and his sister and the girls mouth, in this item there were 5 students have correct answer. Code' question 2.2 C item number 1 and 2 the answer was Eleven kilometers from Cardiff and One day. in this item there were 5 students have correct answer.

Code' question 2.3 A item number 1, 2 and 3 the answer was embarrassing, big tree and my class mate. Code' question 2.3 B item number 1 The town square in this item there were 5 students have correct answer and item number 2 I finally realized that he was not my classmate in this item there were 3 students have correct answer and there were 2 students have incorrect answer.

B. Discussion

The result of the study of reading worksheet for the eight grade students at MTs Raudhatul Jannah Palangka Raya are (i) the students' and teachers' need and responds to the English worksheet at MTs Raudhatul Jannah Palangka Raya; (ii) the kind of worksheet is suitable for reading worksheet as supporting in English teaching at MTs Raudhatul Jannah Palangka Raya.

The result of research data analysis through diagrams from the students' and teachers' response questionnaire. The questionnaire consists of 30 items. Each diagram was checked through per item of the questionnaires. From these diagrams the writer can conclude the final results of the purpose, research which investigate the needs of students and teachers to the worksheet and the types of worksheet are desired by students and teachers based on the need assessment. It is supported by Graves is theory in (chapter II, page 24).

Based on the result of data analysis, it be found that some question in this worksheet quite easy to be understand and quite difficult to be understand it can be seen from the students answer sheet about descriptive items question and recount item question from six task some students have incorrect answer. It because the students difficults in understanding questions they were lazy and they have lack of interest to study reading.

Based on the result of the study, the teachers responded that the worksheet used in the school was so good and interesting, easy to comprehend, appropriate, clear, and unambiguous, very appropriate to the material, easy to do and help to convey the content of materials, very appropriate, the type of task multiple choice, very adequate, good, interest, and suitable with students' and teachers' need, both of very clear. It is supported by Alex Case is theory in (chapter II, page 21)

The students responded that the worksheets which are easy to understand, interested with the kinds of the question in the worksheet that were easy to answer, the worksheet easy to understand, suitable with students need and sometime the question suitable with they want, the worksheet was little bit suitable with what they wanted. It is supported by PKG is theory in (chapter II, page 22).

The result of the study, it can be identified that the teachers needed the worksheet the students were difficult in translation, the worksheet can facilitate of the students to build of their comprehension, facilitate to the students solve their problem in English subject, efficient to increase the students comprehension, easy to comprehend, easy to implementation in learning.

The result of the study, it can be identified that the students needed the worksheet was easy be understand the text in the worksheet, the students saying that learning the worksheet increased their knowledge a lot, was better to use the worksheet, it was better using the worksheet in understanding the material. Based on the students responses, the worksheet used in their class was sometimes the question suitable with they want. So, the students needed the worksheet which was interesting and simple in doing some task and questions.

Based on the result of the study, it can be concluded that both of the students and teachers need the worksheet with the simple and kinds of the question in the worksheet that were easy to answer and increased their knowledge, The material should agree with the syllabus, the worksheet with the instruction to do the task and claer. Most students needed the worksheet with the multiple choice and essay questions. In this case, multiple choice and essay questions gave high and standard learning motivation.
