We have received the review reports of your manuscript. Both reviewers gave positive reviews of your paper. However, some revisions will need to be made for the manuscript to be publishable. The following is the feedback from Reviewer A, while the feedback from Reviewer B is in the attached file.

Reviewer A

The article provides some useful insight into the articles published in TEFLIN Journal from the point of view of bibliometric analysis and the implications on further development of the journal. In terms of content, I would suggest the following point:

"Despite the increasing interest in the bibliometric studies of various disciplines, few studies have been published on the bibliometric overview of the multidisciplinary field of English language teaching (ELT) and its related disciplines such as (applied) linguistics, Second Language Acquisition (SLA), and education. Fortunately, the few studies analyzing the bibliometric indicators of disciplines to the focus and scope of TJ offer a wide range of contexts, i.e. the global, regional, country, and journal levels." --> *make one more step in this paragraph to provide explicit reasons for the need to touch into the TEFLIN Journal.*

In terms of language, I would suggest that the authors carefully proofread the article again to make sure all statements are clear and error-free. For example, these statements are still problematic.

(1) Even though bibliometric research to examine bodies of literature from the levels of topics, regions, nations, and journals is abundant in many fields, it is still limited in the field of the teaching of English as a foreign language, especially at the journal level.--> *the clause "it is still limited" make this statement ambiguous.*

(2) Since the introduction of the index, the three pillars of bibliometrics widely used to --> *has been widely used to*

(3) Figure 4..... --> *make sure to use the official name of the university, whether it is State University of Malang or Universitas Negeri Malang...*

(4) Through the lens of MA, this study captures --> *not sure if the long version of MA has been provided in the previous sections*

Dear Editors of TEFLIN Journal:
Please pay attention to the last sentence of first paragraph in our manuscript. It goes, "Having provided Open Access contents **since its tenth volume** (DOAJ, 2020) ..." We would like to change the phrase since its tenth volume into **since its first volume** but we have specific data or source.

For my article on OAJs in ASEAN countries, in April 2019 I downloaded data from DOAJ. I found that before 2000 there were 41 Indonesian journals proclaiming themselves as Open Access Journals. Unfortunately, I could not find the retrieved data anymore because my computer was broken. The data recently downloaded from DOAJ seem quite dissimilar with the 2019 data because in the latest data we could not find out when a journal provided its OA contents for the first time.

If you could help confirm that TEFLIN Journal has provided Open Access contents since 1990, we would like to revise the phrase in the first paragraph of our manuscript. The revision will be based on, mainly, your confirmation, and, secondarily, my (lost) 2019 data from DOAJ.
